Construction Disputes

- Monetary value of disputes are growing
 - Projects in excess of \$1 billion
 - Australian LNG projects in excess of \$10 billion
- Complexity
 - Organization
 - Scheduling
 - Owner/Contractor interface
 - Peak manpower
- Shift from Lump Sum Turnkey (LSTK) to reimbursable contracts



Construction Disputes

Fast track projects

- Adequacy of front end engineering design (FEED)
- Cost, schedule, and risk implications
- Owner's role and responsibility
 - Oversight versus interference
- Contractor's role and responsibility
 - Means, methods, and reporting
- Cost overruns exceeding liability caps
 - Was there gross negligence, willful misconduct, or fraud?
